CASE 1

Patient Concerns

Patient wanted old composite veneering replaced to make all her teeth look natural and in harmony.

Treatment Selected

To achieve this, Dr. Phillips removed all her old dentistry and replaced it with porcelain veneers using modern advancements in technology and materials.

CASE 3

Patient Concerns

Patient did not like the old porcelain-to-metal crowns and the dark areas at the gum line. She wanted to ensure that all her teeth matched the new brighter crown on the front two teeth.

Treatment Selected

Dr. Phillips placed all-porcelain crowns on her front two teeth and porcelain veneers on the remaining front six teeth to make the smile uniform and bright.



CASE 2

Patient Concerns

Patient wanted to close the space between his teeth that appeared again after his braces were removed. His other concerns were the wear on his teeth, as well as the older dentistry present.

Treatment Selected

Dr. Phillips used a combination of porcelain veneers and porcelain crowns on his teeth. His teeth were lengthened to repair all noticeable wear.

Tooth Replacement. A specially trained dentist uses a screw-like structure placed in your jaw bone to act as the root of a new tooth, which is actually a restoration in the shape and color of your natural tooth. This restoration is custom crafted with porcelain to match the rest of your smile. The result is a strong new tooth that looks and functions just like the rest of your teeth! You can smile with confidence and even eat all the foods as you normally would before you lost your tooth.

Implant Supported Dentures. Implants are placed in various places in your jaw bone. A denture designed just for you is then placed on top of the implants, preserving your jaw bone. This, in turn, supports your overall facial structure, giving you a more youthful appearance. In addition, most patients find that the fit is more comfortable and relieves them of denture related sores. With implant supported dentures, experience a life-like smile with teeth that look and work as natural as your real teeth.
